Enhanced Hydrocarbon Recovery Inc. Addresses the Canadian Standing Senate Committee on Energy, Environment and Natural Resources

Lionel Kambeitz, Executive Chairman of EHR Enhanced Hydrocarbon Recovery (“EHR”) was invited to address the Standing Senate Committee on Energy, the Environment and Natural Resources in Regina.

The Committee is tasked with a long-term study to explore the varied challenges and opportunities associated with achieving energy and economic objectives, while also meeting environmental responsibilities. The hearings are being held across Canada and are meant to be a venue for energy experts, research institutions, government departments and environmental organizations to discuss issues and concerns that may affect the future of Canada’s energy industry.

Mr. Kambeitz addressed the 12 member panel Chaired by W. David Angus (Quebec), on a number of relevant industry issues including:

- Facilitating CO₂ pipeline infrastructure required to move low cost or no cost captured CO₂ to oil fields
- Micro CO₂ capture projects capturing CO₂ from in-situ oil sands and heavy oil production utilizing SAGD, CSS and TADD technologies

- Royalty and tax relief for secondary and tertiary oil production tied to West Texas Intermediate (WTI) oil pricing
- Continued development and public acceptance of Canadian standards and protocols for the geo-sequestration of CO₂, when captured CO₂ cannot be viably utilized for enhanced oil production or other industrial uses
